No matter what anyone says, nothing can prepare a mother for the loss of a child, especially due to violence. If you asked me two years ago where I would be today, I could never have imagined being here, having this role. And although, it is one born of grief and tragic loss, I accept it wholeheartedly as the legacy from my beautiful angel.



I started this foundation to get through the anguish of my grief. I needed a sense of purpose. I couldn't understand why my child and my child's unborn child were taken from us in such a horrific way. I've lived with and around Domestic Violence all my life, but I rarely spoke openly about it. My daughter's death triggered feelings and memories that I had been conditioned to keep secret. I realized that it was time to have a conversation about Domestic Violence, rather than hide behind the silent walls of secrecy to protect our abusers. Domestic Violence is the elephant in the room, and it is passed from generation to generation, and it ultimately took the life of my only child and her unborn baby.

I recognize how critical a role awareness and education play in addressing this. I vow to do everything I can to let other Domestic Violence survivors know that they are not alone.

This is my pledge and promise to my daughter, Jenny, so that she may not have died in vain.

Our mission is to raise awareness and prevent Domestic Violence as a means towards ending the cycle that perpetuates through generations.


