LETTER FROM THE FOUNDER

On February 3, 2019, my daughter, Jennifer Irigoyen, and her unborn baby, my grandson, Evan, were brutally murdered. We waited three long years for justice to be served in a court of law and it was finally so on January 25, 2022, when Anthony Hobson was found guilty on all counts, and sentenced to 26 1/3 years to life, on February 17, 2022.



I started this foundation to get through the anguish of my grief. I needed a sense of purpose while waiting and navigating the criminal justice system and processes. I felt helpless and I wanted to do something. My daughter's death triggered feelings and memories that I had been conditioned to keep secret. I realized that it was time to have a conversation about Domestic Violence, rather than hide behind the silent walls of secrecy to protect our abusers. I recognized the critical role of education in addressing this social issue and I vowed to do everything I could to find FREE resources to help Domestic Violence survivors.

While this mission will always be at the forefront in everything we do, it is constantly evolving. We live in a different world where violence is becoming the norm rather than the exception. We have plans to evolve our mission towards having a conversation about kindness. Our sister website, justiceforjenny.support will house the Domestic Violence Resources while the foundation website will be for providing resources on kindness, love, inclusion and programs for children. This structural separation is necessary to keep the foundation on track with its initial mission.

I thank you with all of my heart for the kindness and support you've given to the foundation these past three years.

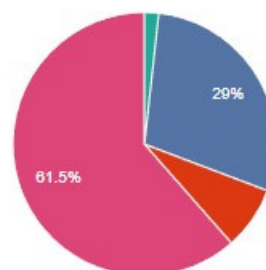
